

FBCSC Celebration Choir Ministry

Purpose:

The worship leading choir member will present special music as part of Sunday worship experience and will participate in special musicals as planned. The choir will also accompany the music minister and praise team in leading the worship service.

Responsibility/Duties:

1. Participate in rehearsals as scheduled.
 - Practice times are very important to the choir ministry. You are encouraged to attend all practices. Practice times are currently on Wednesday (unless specified otherwise) at 7:00pm and Sunday morning before the service to warm-up/review a song (10:15 in the choir room).
 - If you have to miss a practice, it is your responsibility to notify your choir accountability partner (CAP) before the day of the practice.
 - Each member should come to practice with a positive attitude and ready to begin practice. Be attentive and on-task during rehearsal, eliminating any inappropriate talking. A positive, servant-heart and attitude is essential to an effective choir ministry. Questions are encouraged, but any kind of critical spirit is not acceptable. Be conscious of this at all times.
 - Choral notebooks will be distributed to new members. Music will be collected and distributed several times throughout the year and members are to treat both their music and notebooks responsibly and with care. Members may pay a replacement fee if these materials are damaged or lost.
 - Take advantage of the digital resources available through Planning Center (listening to music, etc.)
2. Be available for additional rehearsals and performances for special seasonal musicals at least twice a year.
3. Participate with the choir and praise team on Sunday mornings and other times as scheduled.

Spiritual:

Commitment to Prayer and Bible study—these two Spiritual disciplines need to be a part of your life on a consistent basis.

Punctuality:

It is the expectation that you will be on time for the rehearsals. This allows us the time we need to prepare adequately for the services.

Availability:

1. Doing ministry/preparing for ministry: one to two hours a week
2. Participating in meetings/training: as requested
