Olga grew up in a poor neighborhood in Belarus.

Because she has Down's Syndrome and there are few learning resources affordable for her, Olga never learned to read or write. This prevented her from making an income to help support the family. Then Olga's father passed away, and her only sister married a man who lived on the opposite side of the country.

Left with only her elderly mother and a small government pension, Olga was feeling hopeless. With the arrival of the pandemic, they were even more isolated than normal.

When her church notified Olga's family that Global Hunger Relief food boxes were available to them, she felt a surge of hope and told our partner, "What a joy it was to receive a food package! It felt so good to get out of our apartment and meet with our dear friends at church who told us about Jesus. I know many songs and poems about Jesus now, and my mom says these groceries will last us a long time."
